ORCA GEAR: What You Need, and Where to Find It

TEAM SUIT: We're using the same team suit as last year, as promised. It's the "Tyr" brand "Equinox" model (see picture insert). Female suits are \$40 + tax, Male suits (jammers) are \$27 + tax

If you prefer to use a plain black racing suit, we're allowing that option as well, this year. Either can be purchased at Lane 4 Swim Store, where you also receive a team discount:

OTHER REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

- One set of fins per swimmer
- One kickboard per swimmer
- One pair of goggles per swimmer
- Wild Orca swim cap (one latex cap will be provided to each swimmer for free, and swimmers will all be expected to wear a cap at meets, but not at practice)

Lane Four Swim Shop will be at Westover Club beginning at 3:00 on May 12th (the first day of practice) selling team suits and other gear. If you plan to purchase your child's suit on that day, please leave time to do this **BEFORE practice**, as **swimmers must be dry in order to try on suits!**
